Bouldering Regulations

Most Important Rule - FAIR PLAY

It should be needless to say, but we expect fair play from all teams! Please respect your opponents as well as the decisions of the judges and try to act as fair as possible.

The United World Games Bouldering competition will be held in cooperation with the Naturfreunde Kärnten.



1. Age Groups

Category	Years of Birth
U8 m/f	2013 – 2014
U10 m/f	2011 – 2012
U12 m/f	2009 – 2010
U14 m/f	2007 – 2008
U16 m/f	2005 – 2006
U20 m/f	2001 – 2004

2. ID Checks

Every climber is obliged to bring a passport or ID to the tournament. If requested, every climber must be able to prove his or her identity to the tournament administration.

3. Climbing Mode

Qualification: 8 boulder, 8 tries per boulder

Possible Superfinals: 1 boulder, 1 try per boulder

4. Rules and General Remarks

The valid international climbing rules of the IFSC as well as the valid Austrian regulations of the climbing association Austria (KVÖ) apply.

- Jump-off safety is assured by soft jump mats
- 4 to 10 tries per boulder
- Only wall/volume/handles/steps may be used
- Appeals must be made 5 minutes after the valuation round!
- Technical details at the team captain meeting
- Top is only valid if the top grip is held onto **firmly** with **both hands**.
- A valid **hold** has to be confirmed by the referee.
- The starting permission is given only by the referee
- The starter change takes place after each attempt

With their registration participants fully accept the current competition rules, anti-doping rules, officials' instructions and the organizer's rules. Important note: The team captains and/or caregivers are advised that the duty of supervision of underage participants is not assumed by the organizer. Special regulations for the competition as well as the quotas of the finalists (if provided) and any rule changes will be announced by the jury president at the team leader meeting before the beginning of the competition.

4. Insurance & Disclaimer

The participants are not insured through the organizers. It is up to the coach of each team to make sure that his/her players and all the participants of the team are insured during the event. The organizers do not assume any kind of liability in case of illness, accidents or loss/theft of personal belongings.

With their participation the athletes accept the disclaimer of warranty for any kind of damage. No claims can be asserted against the organizing committee, the event sponsors, the city of Klagenfurt and the province of Carinthia regarding damage or injuries.

Every athlete has to make sure that they are fully physically capable of participating without any medical objections.

For all climbers: Do not leave any valuables and/or sports equipment unattended.

5. Final Remark

The organizers of the United World Games are at the understanding that each participant and team leader knows all the items as mentioned in these regulations.

IMPORTANT: In emergencies the emergency number 144 must be called. Please also note that if an injured athlete has to be transported to the hospital with an ambulance, a coach, manager or parent/guardian of the affected team must always accompany them.
